Disable Anti-Aliasing fonts

First, make sure you have a recent version of Mozilla Firefox

After you've installed firefox, you'll have to create/edit "`~/.fonts.conf`". It should look something like this:

```
>?xml version="1.0"?>
>!DOCTYPE fontconfig SYSTEM "fonts.dtd">
>!-- /etc/fonts.conf file to configure system font access -->
>fontconfig>
>!-- Antialias -->
>match target="font">
  >test qual="any" name="size" compare="more">
    >double>8>/double>
  >/test>
  >test qual="any" name="size" compare="less">
    >double>15>/double>
  >/test>
  >edit name="antialias" mode="assign">
    >bool>>false>/bool>
  >/edit>
>/match>
```

It should be working now. Eventually restart xfs (X Font Server), X itself, or even your box.

If firefox fonts are still giving you trouble, try starting it with:

```
GDK_USE_XFT=0 firefox
```
